The CFPB's renumbering reflects the codification of its regulations in Title 12 (Banks and Banking), Chapter X (Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection) of the CFR. For example, before July 21, 2011, the Federal Reserve had rulemaking authority for the Home Mortgage Disclosure Act, which was codified in Title 12, Chapter II (Federal Reserve System), Part 203. The CFPB's implementing regulation for the Home Mortgage Disclosure Act is now codified in Title 12, Chapter X, Part 1003. In addition to changes related to the renumbering of the CFPB regulations, the manual incorporates updated interagency examination procedures for the Truth in Lending Act (TILA) and for the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), both of which were revised to reflect statutory and regulatory changes. Specifically, changes to the TILA procedures include amendments to TILA and its implementing Regulation Z pursuant to the Credit Card Accountability Responsibility and Disclosure Act of 2009. Changes to the FCRA procedures include Dodd-Frank Act amendments that require the disclosure of a credit score and related information when a credit score is used in taking an adverse action or in risk-based pricing. Finally, the manual was updated to incorporate: new examination procedures released since the issuance of the manual in October 2011 (covering mortgage origination; short-term, small-dollar lending; SAFE Act; and consumer reporting); the June 21, 2012, Interagency Guidance on Mortgage Servicing Practices Concerning Military Homeowners with Permanent Change of Station Orders; and, technical corrections and formatting changes. **2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design** Department Justice 2014-10-09 (a) Design and construction. (1) Each facility or part of a facility constructed by, on behalf of, or for the use of a public entity shall be designed and constructed in such manner that the facility or part of

the facility is readily accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities, if the construction was commenced after January 26, 1992.

(2) Exception for structural impracticability. (i) Full compliance with the requirements of this section is not required where a public entity can demonstrate that it is structurally impracticable to meet the requirements. Full compliance will be considered structurally impracticable only in those rare circumstances when the unique characteristics of terrain prevent the incorporation of accessibility features. (ii) If full compliance with this section would be structurally impracticable, compliance with this section is required to the extent that it is not structurally impracticable. In that case, any portion of the facility that can be made accessible shall be made accessible to the extent that it is not structurally impracticable. (iii) If providing accessibility in conformance with this section to individuals with certain disabilities (e.g., those who use wheelchairs) would be structurally impracticable, accessibility shall nonetheless be ensured to persons with other types of disabilities, (e.g., those who use crutches or who have sight, hearing, or mental impairments) in accordance with this section.
