While these systems have become institutions that we cannot spare, a further regulation of them is required in order to secure the greatest good of the greatest number. Electric wires are not only active agents in causing fires, but they also frequently embarrass the efforts of the department to extinguish them. Some of these lines are so thickly run in front of buildings as to render it almost impossible to raise ladders for ventilation, calling up hose, or saving life. In a number of cases these lines were established before the buildings were erected, and the resultant relations are unfortunate. It might be a

proper question of public policy to inquire whether in many such instances the wires might not be carried over the buildings, instead of alongside, until such time as the city shall get ready to order the wires underground.
